**General Instructions for Poster Preparation and uploading thereof in International Conference on “Strategies for global food and nutritional security, sustainability and wellness” NUTRI2023 - December 04-06, 2023 at CCS Haryana Agricultural University Hisar (Haryana) INDIA**

- Poster display will be limited to one side of board as per the recommended poster dimension.
- The registration number of delegate must be placed on the upper left-hand corner of the display and to be visible at all times.
- Be sure to include the abstract title, author and co-author names, the institution (s) affiliation. Place your e-mail address and mobile no.
- The poster should include the headings “Introduction / Background [state the problem or area of investigation with clear objectives],” Materials & Methods [lab techniques, experimental design, sampling methods, data source, timelines, etc.],” “Results & Discussion [graphs, photos, tables; all data should be in Standard units.],” “Summary / Conclusions [Interpretation and implications]”, “References [include key references not more than five]” and “Acknowledgement if any”
- Refer to your acceptance letter and / or the final conference program for the time and location of your poster session and set-up time.
- It is recommended that you hand-carry your poster to the conference, using tubular packaging or a portfolio case. Costs associated with creating and shipping the poster display will be the responsibility of the authors.
- The designated poster presenter (author or co-author) must be present at the assigned place during the designated time to discuss the work presented.

**Figures, Tables and Photos:**

- ❖ Figures can be understood much more easily and more quickly than tables; convert tables to figures, if possible.
- ❖ Keep figures simple. Use bold lines and large symbols for easy reading from a distance.
- ❖ Each figure should be accompanied by a short line of interpretation that summarizes the message of the figure.
- ❖ Photographs should be clear and of good quality.

**Tips for Poster Preparation**

- ▶ Posters should stimulate discussion, not give a long presentation. Therefore, keep text to a minimum, emphasize graphics, and make sure every item included in your poster is necessary.
- ▶ Make sure ideas flow logically from one section to the next.
- ▶ Use charts and graphs to illustrate data (avoid large tables of raw data).
- ▶ Use high resolution photographs (web images often will not work).
- ▶ Do not use all capital letters.
- ▶ Choose your colors to provide strong contrast and avoid pairing red and green elements to assist those with red-green color blindness

**Be consistent.**

- Keep consistent margins.
- Keep line spacing consistent.
- Keep the color, style, and thickness of borders the same.
- Keep shading consistent.
- Use easily read type with font size. Hence, title should be legible from 10 feet far.
- Body text should legible from 5 feet far.
