DIPLOMA IN AGROCHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS

Scope and opportunities: The diploma is designed for the people who do not have basic knowledge of various inputs of agriculture with reference to agrochemicals and fertilizers. This diploma will enable the extension workers, agri-input dealers and other workers to build their technical competency in agrochemicals and fertilizers uses in agriculture and to serve the farming community in a better way.

Duration: One year (Two semesters)

Academic year: July, 2020 to June, 2021 with two sessions.

Centre for execution of diploma:

- College of Agriculture, Hisar
- College of Agriculture, Kaul (Kaithal)
- iii) College of Agriculture, Bawal (Rewari)

Total Seats: 30 seats (including 10 seats which are preferred to industrysponsored candidates) at each centre i.e., Hisar, Kaul and Bawal. Minimum 15 seats have to be filled for starting diploma.

Eligibility: 12" standard

Age limit: Minimum 18 years and maximum 55 years.
