Tenders must be sent by post in a sealed envelope by due date or be delivered in person by the tenderers or by their agents to the <u>Prof. & Head</u>. Tenders must be scribed on the envelope as "Tenders for the Lab/Farm work of scheme and address of the <u>Prof. & Head</u>. CCS HAU. On the envelope tenderer's address be also given as 'From______ (with name and address of the quotee) on the other side of the envelope.
- 2. Submit the quotation with the GST Number
- 3. GST Number should be registered with excise and taxation department.
- 4. GST will be applicable as per Govt. rules.
- 5. Interested contractors having GST number are requested to submit their tenders separately for Garden & Floriculture crops.
- 6. The Contractor may certify in his quotation/tender that no other member of his family has quoted rates for this work.
- 7. Earnest money amounting to 2% must accompany each tender in the shape of National Plan Certificate or Deposit-at-Call Receipt/draft of any Schedule Bank at Hisar and each tender is to be sent in a sealed cover super-scribed "Tender for the Lab/Farm work of scheme and addressed to the Prof. & Head, CCS HAU.
- 8. Tenders not accompanied with earnest money in shape of National Plan Saving Certificate or Deposit-at-Call receipt at any Schedule Bank at and the amount of earnest money pledged to the Prof. & Head, Department of Horticulture shall not be considered. In case of the non-acceptance of the tenders, these are liable to be rejected.

- 15. The Contractor shall ensure to make the payment as DC rate (minimum) otherwise his contract will be terminated and he will be declared blacklisted for University services.

 - b) Workers are paid the minimum wages at least as provided under the minimum wages Act-1948.
 - c) Wages slips are issued regularly to the worker by the Contractors.
- 17. In case of any loss due to negligence of contractual worker's, the Contractor shall be responsible to make good loss to the <u>HOD</u>, failing which the amount of loss shall be recovered/adjusted from earnest money.
- 18. It will be sole responsibility of the Contractor to compensate the labour on account of injury, loss of life or limb in accordance with the law in force the time being. The University will in no way be responsible for such loss.
- 19. The Contractor shall be required to provide small Agril. Implements i.e. Kassi, Kasola and Drati etc. He will have to work as per instructions given by the Farm Manager/Agril. Inspector/Research Associate/Lab Incharge at the site.
- 20. It will also be the responsibility and liability of the Contractor to adhere to the provisions of the ESI and Provident Fund Act and in case they are not followed properly, he himself be responsible for it.
- 21. In case of breach of terms and conditions of the contract or any of them, the contract shall be cancelled and the contractor blacklisted. The remaining job shall be got done at the risk and cost of the contractor who has defaulted.
- 22. The University reserves the right of supervision. Transport for transporting labour will not be provided by University.
- 23. The parties may visit the site and contact the <u>Garden Incharge</u>, <u>Dept.of Horticulture</u>, <u>CCS HAU</u>, <u>Hisar</u> for this purpose before submitting their tenders.
