

Terms and conditions of the tender:

1. Tender will be received by the Prof. & Head, Department of Vegetable Science, CCS HAU, Hisar up to **29.10.2021 at 11.00 a.m.** and will be opened by the committee on **29.10.2021 at 3.30 p.m.** in the O/O Prof. & Head, Department of Vegetable Science. Tenders must be sent by post in a sealed envelope by due date or be delivered in person by the tenderers or their agent to the Head, Department of Vegetable Science. Tenders are super scribed on envelope as "Tenders for the Lab/Farm work of scheme and address of the HOD/Section be mentioned clearly. On the envelope tenderer's address be also given as From _____ (with name and address of the quote) on the other side of the envelope.
2. Earnest money as mentioned against each scheme must accompany each tender in the shape of National Plan Certificate/ Deposit-at-Call receipt of any scheduled Bank at Hisar and each tender is to be sent sealed cover super scribed "Tender for the lab/ Farm work of scheme and address the Prof.& Head, Department of Vegetable Science, CCS HAU, Hisar."
3. Tender not accompanied with earnest money in shape of National Plan Certificate of deposited at call receipt any schedule Bank at and the amount of earnest money Pledged to the Prof.& Head, Department of Vegetable Science, CCS HAU, Hisar shall not be considered. In case of non-acceptance of the tenders, the amount shall be refunded to them on the same day.
4. Conditional tenders are liable to be rejected.
5. The contractor shall be required to sign the contract agreement on bond paper of Rs. 15/- on the prescribed form within ten days of the intimation of the acceptance of tender to him. Failure on his part to do so may result in invalidation of the contract and forfeiture of the earnest money.
6. Income tax @ 2.0 % to be deducted from the bills at source.
7. The contractor will have to execute the job within the given time and no request for extension for time shall be entertained except in unforeseen circumstances.
8. Payment will be made after completion of the job satisfactorily on monthly basis.
9. The acceptance of the tender will rest with Head, Department of Vegetable Science who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender and reserves himself the authority to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason therefore. All tenders in which the conditions are not fulfilled will be rejected.
10. The contractor shall be responsible for observance of the Provisions of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970. The University shall not be responsible for it in any manner.

11. In case of any loss due to negligence of contractual workers, the contractor shall be responsible to make good loss to the HOD, failing which the amount of loss shall be recovered /adjusted from earnest money.
12. It will be sole responsibility of the contractor to compensate the labour because of injury, loss of life or limb in accordance with the law in force for the time being. The University will in no way be responsible for such loss.
13. The contractor shall be required to provide small agril. Implements (Hand tools) i.e. Kassi, Kasola and Dranti etc. He will have to work as per instructions given by the Farm Manager/Agril. Inspector/Research Associate/Lab. Incharge on the site.
14. It will be the responsibility and liability of the contractor to adhere to the provisions of the ESI and Provident Fund Act and in case they are not followed properly, he himself will be responsible for it.
15. In case of breach of terms and conditions of the contract or any of them, the contract shall be cancelled and the contractor blacklisted. The remaining job shall be got done at the risk and cost of the contractor who has defaulted.
16. The university reserves the right of supervision. Transport for transporting labour not be provided by the University.
17. The parties may visit the site and contact HOD Vegetable science, CCS HAU, Hisar for this purpose before submitting their tenders.
18. In case of any dispute between the parties, the same will be referred to the arbitration of the Vice-chancellor and his decision shall be final. The provisions of Indian Arbitration Act shall apply to these proceedings.
19. The contractor should not use insulting language against any worker.
20. The contractor must issue attendance card to each worker employed by him in connection with field operational work so that record pertaining to the attendance of workers should be in the notice of workers.
21. As per the provision in the Contract Labour Act, 1970, the contractors shall be responsible for the payment of wages as per D.C. approved rates before expiry of such period as may be prescribed. Any litigation arise due to non-compliance of above conditions will be responsibility of the contractor and settle by him.
22. Contractors will give break up of wages, PG and ESI in the tender to be offered by them pertaining to field operational work. They may obtain the PF and ESI code from competent authority.
23. It will be sole responsibility of contractor to supply copy of challan regarding PF/ESI.
24. Workmen deployed through contractors for field operational work abide by the following provisions strictly:-
 - a) Workers are paid wages by 7th of every month by contractor.
 - b) Workers are paid the minimum wages at least as provided under minimum Wages Act.
 - c) Wages slip is issued regularly to the workers by the contractors.
 - e) Necessary certificate regarding the above provisions (a to c) be also got recorded in the wages register from Principal Employer or the person who is authorized in this behalf by the Principal employer.
25. If the contractor employees 20 or more than this in a particular contract then he should obtain licence from the Labour Department and submit the same to the Principal Employer. Enclose a photocopy of licence along with tender offered.
26. Contractor should obtain licence from the Labour Department and submit the same to the Principal Employer.
27. The tenders of contractors having PF,ESI code may be accepted in response to tender notice and in case the contractors do not have any code, they should obtain the code from the competent authority.
28. Contractors will have to submit a copy of challan regarding PF, ESI to Dept. of Vegetable Science.
29. The workman deployed through the contractors for field operational work may be paid the minimum wages as per provisions contained under the wages Act and that provisions of working hours may be fixed for them. EPF provisions may also be followed strictly by the contractors. The worker may also be paid minimum wages well in time every month, besides to issue wages slip to them.
