Guidelines for NSS Award

Criteria for eligibility and performance evaluation

1) The NSS Units and Programme Officer

i) Eligibility conditions

The following conditions should be fulfilled in order to be eligible for consideration for the

Award:

- a) The programme officer who is being considered for the Award, should have completed at least 2 years as Programme Officer of the unit (as on the last date of the year for which the award is being conferred)
- b) The NSS unit should have adopted a village and organised two Special Cramps in the adopted village during the period of award.

ii) Criteria for performance evaluation:

The performance of the NSS unit shall be evaluated based of the objective criteria, including their achievements in plantation of saplings, blood donation, immunisation camp, organisation of awareness programmes/ rallies, shramadaan, cleanness programmes and other outstanding achievements.

2) NSS Volunteers:

i) Eligibility conditions

The following conditions should be fulfilled in order to be eligible for consideration for the Award:

- a) The NSS volunteer should have completed 2 years volunteer ship under NSS during the year for which award is being conferred (student registered in NSS from July 2019 to June 2021).
- b) The NSS volunteer should have attended at least one Annual NSS Special Camp in the village during the period.
- c) The NSS volunteer should have completed course of First aid and Home Nursing during the period.
- d) The NSS volunteer should have at least two Appreciation certificate from NSS Unit.

ii) Criteria for performance evaluation:

The performance of the NSS volunteer shall be evaluated based of the objective criteria, including their achievements in plantation of saplings, blood donation, attending immunisation camp, attending of awareness programmes/ rallies, shramdaan, cleanness programmes and other outstanding achievements.
