



AUCTION NOTICE (Guava upto October,2024)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER

Tender quotations with copy of receipt of tender-form-cost will be received by the HOD, Forestry up to **09.12.2022 at 5.00 P.M.** and will be opened by the Tender Opening Committee on **12.12.2022 at 11.00 A.M.** in the office of HOD, Forestry in the presence of such tenderers who may like to be present. Tenders must be super subscribed on the envelope with job description, name and address of the quote on the envelope.

1. Earnest money of Rs.2000/- must be accompanied with each tender in the shape of National Plan certificate/Demand Draft of any scheduled bank at Hisar and each tender to be sent under sealed cover. Tenders not accompanied with earnest money in the shape mentioned above shall not be considered and amount shall be refunded on the same day in case of the non-acceptance of the tender. Tender application fee is Rs. 100/- + 18% GST.
2. 25% of the bid value will have to be deposited by highest bidder with the receipt of official orders and the remaining amount will have to be paid before taking over the management of Guava plants, failing which the earnest money will be forfeited. An amount of Rs. 5000/- (Five thousand only) will have to be deposited as security before the start of look after of the plants.
3. Two kg (02) of fruits per season/year will be reserved for research purpose from both the systems i.e. agri-horti and agri-silvi-horti system including Guava plants in control treatment.
4. The scientists of the department are free to select the fruit plants for research purpose in any part of the agri-horti and agri-silvi-horti system and give the required treatments.
5. The University is not liable to compensate any loss to the guava plants caused in the agri-horti and agri-silvi-horti system due to natural calamities.
6. The Contractor cannot sublet the contract further to any other person.
7. The Contractor has to provide proper identity card and submit a passport size photo of all his workers to the department.
8. The Guava fruits in agri-horti and agri-silvi-horti system including control may be auctioned on the condition that the security and labour for the management up to October, 2024 i.e. for the period of contract will be borne by the contractor. If the labour is not provided timely for management of guava fruits plants in AF system then the field operations will be carried out by the department at the risk and cost of contractor.
9. In case of mismanagement of the Guava plants in AF system, the University reserves the right to cancel the contract without assigning any reason.
10. All the operational cost done on Guava plants for increase in fruit bearing will be borne by the contractor. The source of irrigation in the agri-horti and agri-silvi-horti system is tubewell and canal irrigation.
11. The contractor will continue to manage the guava plants in AF system using his labour even after the harvest of the intermediate fruit yield up to October 2024 so as to expect a good crop.
12. Penalty will be imposed as deemed fit by the University in case any damage to the trees, University property caused by labour/contractor.
13. The Contractor should strictly follow the provisions mentioned below:
 - a) Workers are paid wages by 7th of every month.
 - b) Workers are paid the minimum wages at least as provided under the minimum wages Act- 1948 and the Govt. instructions issued from time to time.
 - c) Wages slips are issued regularly to the worker by the Contractors.
14. It will also be the responsibility and liability of the Contractor to adhere to the provisions of the ESI and Provident Fund Act and in case they are not followed properly, he himself be responsible for it.
15. The Contractor may certify in his quotation that no other member of his family has quoted rates for this work.

16. The contractor shall be required to sign the contract agreement on the non-judicial bond paper of Rs. 15/- on the prescribed form within ten days from the intimation of the acceptance of the tender. Failure of the same, the contract money shall be forfeited and may result into invalidation of contract.
17. The Contractor shall be responsible for observance of the provision of the contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 and he will pay the minimum wages to the labour. The University shall not be responsible for it in any manner.
18. It will be sole responsibility of the Contractor to compensate the labour on account of injury, loss of life or limb in accordance with the law in force the time being. The University will in no way be responsible for such loss.
19. The University will not provide any Agril. Implements i.e. Kassi, Kasola and Drati etc. He will have to work as per instructions given by the Area Incharge/HOD from time to time.
20. In case of breach of terms and conditions of the contract or any of them, the contract shall be cancelled and the contractor will be blacklisted. The remaining job shall be got done at the risk and cost of the contractor who has defaulted.
21. The University reserves the right of supervision.
22. The parties may visit the site and contact the Area Incharge / Prof. & Head, Dept of Forestry, CCS HAU, for this purpose before quoting their rates.
23. In case of any dispute between the parties the same will be referred for the arbitration to the Director of Research and his decision shall be final. The provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act shall apply to these proceedings.
24. Any legal dispute will be subject to the Hisar court of law.
25. Intercrops will also be taken between agri-horti and agri-silvi-horti system during the contract period as per the requirement of the department of Forestry.
26. Any other condition as laid down by the University, if required during the tenure of contract period will be binding upon the contractor
