Call for Papers

Authors are invited to submit abstract of their research work in the format on the web link : <https://www.hau.ac.in/intclimate2023/>. The abstract should be typed in english language using MS word (single space; font –Times New Roman; font size-12 and should not exceed 250 words. The abstract must contain title of the paper, name(s) of the author followed by their affiliation, contact number and e-mail. The name of presenting author must be underlined. After peer review, paper will be selected for oral / poster presentation and will be informed accordingly. At least one author should register for the conference after obtaining NOC from co-authors. The presenting author will also submit undertaking that the abstract has not been presented/ published previously anywhere and there is no conflict of interest. Delegates, after successful registration, shall be required to furnish travel itinerary to assure smooth arrangements necessary for accommodation and transport. Accommodation may not be guaranteed for spot registration.

Accommodation

Registered delegates will be accommodated in Faculty House and Farmers Hostel at the university campus or at the available guest houses in different institutes on first-come first served basis on official prescribed rates. About the University

Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University popularly known as HAU, is one of Asia's biggest agricultural universities, located at Hisar in the Indian state of Haryana. It is named after India's seventh Prime Minister, Chaudhary Charan Singh. It is a leader in agricultural research in India and contributed significantly to Green Revolution and White Revolution during 1960s and 70s. It has a very large campus and has several research centres throughout the state. HAU was initially a campus of Punjab Agricultural University, Ludhiana. After the formation of Haryana in 1966, it became an autonomous institution on February 2, 1970 through a Presidential Ordinance, later ratified as Haryana and Punjab Agricultural Universities Act, 1970, passed by the Lok Sabha on March 29, 1970. University is spread over an area of 7219 acres at Hisar and 1426 acres at outstations. During its existence so far it has made rapid progress in building an excellent infrastructure. It has one of the best developed campuses in India to meet academic and extra-curricular needs of the students.



About the City

Once known as Hisar-e-Firoza by its Turkic ruler founder Firuz Shah Tughlaq in the year 1354 AD. He adorned his new town with several historical buildings such as fort, palaces, tombs, mosques, gates and gardens. Some of monuments are still in good state of preservation. 'Hisar' is an Arabic word which means 'Fort'. It is situated one hundred eighty kilometers west to Delhi and is one of the important cities of North India, located at 29°09'N and 75°42'E in the state of Haryana. Several educational institutions including reputed educational CCS Haryana Agricultural University, Guru Jambheshwar University and Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences are established in Hisar. Ever since, the Government's positive policies have played a vital role in the economic development of the city. The industrial policy of the government has attracted large number of entrepreneurs and resulted into the industrialization in and around the city.



Climate

The climate of Hisar owes to its continental location on the outer margins of the south-west (SW) monsoon region. It has tropical monsoonal climate and is characterized as arid type of climate. The average annual rainfall is around 450 mm. The maximum day temperature during the summer varies between 40°C to 46°C. During winter it ranges between highest at 28°C to lowest being around 3°C. The highest amount of dew fall is observed in December and January, whereas, lowest in April and November months. Weather during the conference period would be congenial.
