The College of Agriculture, Bawal was established with the aim to provide agricultural education to rural students in the resource-poor districts of Haryana. With a focus on academic, research and extension need, the college currently has 389 undergraduate, 42 post-graduate and 21 Ph.D. students. The college boasts excellent infrastructure facilities, including academic building, hostels, multimedia classrooms, well-equipped laboratories, seminar room, cafeteria, examination hall, computer/language lab, library and students' farm. It also



provides well-maintained sports facilities, NSS unit and various co-curricular activities for the holistic development of students.

For acquiring academic and professional excellence, in addition to classroom teaching, students are exposed to one-year practical crop production program and six-months Rural Agricultural Work Experience (RAWE) that also includes industrial exposure. The curriculum encompasses agro-based skill-oriented modules, study tours, exposure visits and research opportunities for the students. The rural environment in which students reside and study, prepares them to learn the traditional knowledge and advance agricultural technologies to serve the farming community and contribute to the growth of country, effectively.

FACILITIES

A. Smart Classrooms & Laboratories: College has a spacious building having six smart classrooms equipped with latest multimedia facilities. There are 18 well equipped modern laboratories related to different disciplines of Agriculture, Basic Sciences and Engineering.

B. Library: All the computers at College of Agriculture, Bawal are connected with CeRa, IndiaStat and other online facility through Nehru Library, CCS HAU, Hisar. The Gateway is connected with internet facility. There are about 5500 books and journals in the library.



C. Computer & Language Lab: The College has Words Worth Language Lab with 30 computers and other facilities like voice input and output devices to compare the pronunciation and to listen the video/ audio for improvement in language.



D. Hostels: The College has separate hostels for Boys and Girls with accommodation capacity of 150 and 95 students, respectively, decorated with lawn and ornamental plants. Two more hostels, one each for girls and boys are under construction. For the overall mental and physical improvements of the students the hostels have indoor facilities for sports and recreational activities such as gym, table tennis, yoga, TV room, Wi-Fi, canteen, reading hall and solar system panels.



E. Examination Hall: The College has one examination hall to conduct the examinations having the seating capacity of 250 students.

F. Auditorium: College of Agriculture, Bawal has one auditorium under construction having seating capacity for 450.

G. Guest House: There is a well furnished Guest House having one VIP room, three AC rooms and fifteen ordinary rooms for accommodation of the visitors. The guest house also has meal facility along with recreational hall & badminton hall.

H. Sports and Recreation Facilities: College of Agriculture, Bawal witnessed a plethora of vibrant and engaging sports activities. Students enthusiastically participate in various sports, fostering a spirit of competitiveness and camaraderie. College has well developed playgrounds and different game courts for cricket, Kabaddi, football, basketball court, volleyball, badminton and athletic track for students and faculty. Indoor recreation facilities for boys and girls such are also available at hostels. For mental fitness of the students and staff, regular yoga camps and other events are organized time to time.

I. Residential Area for Staff and Faculty: The College has accommodation facility for the staff and faculty members in the campus. There are 38 residential quarters for faculty and other staff.

J. Cattle Farm: The College has one cattle farm with shed, drinking water facility and having more than 50 cattle. There is 12 acres land for grazing of animals.

K. Landscape Unit: The College has well established landscaping unit which engages the beautification of the college campus.

L. Experiential Learning Programme: Pre-final year students are allowed to opt ELP based on their interest. In this unit, students are trained for preparation of different products viz. bael squash, bael RTS, aonla candy and murabba etc. Some more products are also prepared on the basis of availability of fruit and rates of material.

M. Canteen: College has spacious canteen facility in its premises. A variety of high-quality hygienic food items and snacks are provided to the students and staff at reasonable rates.

N. Medical Facilities: A health clinic facility under an MBBS doctor is working for students, staff and family.



STUDENTS' WELFARE ACTIVITIES

One faculty has been assigned the duties of ADSW for liaising with the Directorate of Students' Welfare (DSW) for the welfare of the students. Different type of activities for personality development of students like NSS, sports and cultural and trainings etc. are conducted at college. The college also provides information about competitive examinations, job opportunities, scholarships/fellowships etc. to the students. It also conducts trainings on personality development, entrepreneurship, motivational and professional lectures for the overall personal and professional development of the students. This cell also provides information regarding placement, admissions, scholarships, fellowships etc. in India and abroad and arrange campus interviews for job in the public and private sectors for the students.
