About the College

University has three Colleges of Agriculture (COA), one each in Hisar, Kaul and Bawal. COA, Hisar is located in main campus of CCS HAU, Hisar and offering B. Sc. (Hons.) Ag. 4-year programme, M. Sc. (Ag.), M.Sc. Forestry, MBA (Gen.), MBA (Agri Business) and Ph. D. degrees. COA, Kaul is situated on the Karnal-Pehowa road 170 km from Delhi and 150 km from Hisar and offering B.Sc. (Hons.) Ag.4-year programme, M.Sc. (Ag.) and Ph.D degrees. COA, Bawal is situated at Bawal at a distance of 12 K.M. from Rewari and 3 K.M. from Delhi-Jaipur National Highway No. 8 and offering B.Sc. (Hons.) Ag. 4-year programme, B.Sc. (Hons.) Ag. 6-year (2+4) programme, M.Sc. (Ag.) and Ph.D degrees. Besides above degree programmes, each college is also offering one year Diploma course in Agrochemicals and Fertilizers.

Detailed Information About Diploma

Name of Diploma: Diploma in Agrochemicals and Fertilizers

Scope and opportunities: The diploma is designed for the people who do not have basic knowledge of various inputs of agriculture with reference to agrochemicals and fertilizers. This diploma will enable the extension workers, agri-input dealers and other workers to build their technical competency in agrochemicals and fertilizers uses in agriculture and to serve the farming community in a better way.

Duration: One year (2 semesters)

Academic year: 2024-2025

Centre for execution of diploma:

- i) College of Agriculture, Hisar
- ii) College of Agriculture, Kaul (Kaithal)
- iii) College of Agriculture, Bawal (Rewari)

Total Seats: 30 seats (including 10 seats which are preferred to industry-sponsored candidates) at each centre i.e., Hisar, Kaul and Bawal. Minimum 20 seats have to be filled up for starting diploma.

Eligibility: 12th standard

Age limit: Minimum 18 years and maximum 55 years.

Selection procedure: On the basis of marks secured in 12th examination and experience gained in relevant field on 80:20 ratios. Six months experience carries 5.0 marks with a limit of 2 years for consideration.

Fee: Rs 20,000 per semester (Rs 40,000 annually) for non-sponsored candidate. For Industry-sponsored candidate, fee is Rs 1.0 lakh per semester (Rs 2.0 lakh annually).

Credit hours requirement: 24 credit hours (12 credit hours per semester)

Medium of Instruction: English

Attendance requirement: At least 75 per cent in theory and practical separately.

Examination pattern: Semester system.

Passing marks for diploma: Minimum 33 per cent in each course and with an aggregate of 35 per cent for acquiring diploma.

Maximum duration of diploma: Maximum period of diploma can be extended up to four semesters. Further, the duration of diploma can be extended up to 6 semesters on the special permission of Worthy Vice-Chancellor.

Accommodation: As per the availability of rooms in farmers' hostel at university rate.

1. Prospectus shall be available on university website (www.hau.ac.in) for submission of offline application form for admission in 'Diploma for Agrochemicals and Fertilizers' at opted executive centre of diploma (Hisar/Kaul/Bawal).
2. Fees for submission of offline application for General category are Rs 500/- and Rs 125 for SC/BC/EWS.
3. Demand draft may be prepared in favour of execution centre i.e., Dean, College of Agriculture (Hisar) or Principal, College of Agriculture (Kaul) or Principal, College of Agriculture (Bawal).
4. Opening and closing date for submitting offline application form for admission at opted execution centre for diploma are 20.09.2024 and 19.10.2024, respectively for Haryana residents.
