The Western Sydney University, Australia invites nominations for Dual degree direct Ph.D. Degree Programme at Sydney, Australia in some disciplines. This year preferred Research Areas for Ph.D at WSU are as under. -

- Horticultural crops management
- Data Science
- Soil Microbiomes
- Agricultural Engineering.

The amount of tuition fees waiver for their research work is mentioned below:

Tuition Fee

- Eligibility criteria for admission including **OGPA of 9.0** or higher in a recognized Master of Science or Equivalent program will result in a **full tuition fee waiver for 48 months**.
- Eligibility criteria for admission including **OGPA of between 8.5-8.9** in a recognized Master of Science or Equivalent program will result in a full tuition fee waiver while the candidate is offshore and a **75% tuition fee waiver** while the candidate is on shore at Western.
- Eligibility criteria for admission including **OGPA of between 8.0-8.4** in a recognized Master of Science or Equivalent program will result in a full tuition fee waiver while the candidate is offshore and a **50% tuition fee waiver** while the candidate is on shore at Western.

Scholarship Stipend: No WSU scholarship stipend will be awarded.

Candidature Project Funds

WSU will provide Candidature Project Funds (up to the value of \$6,000 AUD per annum pro rata for high-cost projects and a lesser amount for low-cost project) for the duration the Candidate is onshore at WSU as per agreement.


The students will do their doctoral degree course work at CCSHAU and research work will be conducted at WSU, Sydney, Australia. The student has to pay their usual fees for course work at CCSHAU, Hisar.
