Subject : Invitation of Ph.D Students for Dual Degree Programme at Western Sydney University, Australia and CCS HAU, Hisar 2026-27.





The amount of tuition fees waiver for their research work is mentioned below:

Tuition fee

- Eligibility criteria for admission including OGPA of 9.0 or higher in a recognized Master of Science or Equivalent program will result in a full tuition fee waiver for 48 months.
- Eligibility criteria for admission including OGPA of between 8.5-8.9 in a recognized Master of Science or fee waiver while the candidates is on shore at Western.
- Eligibility criteria for admission including OGPA of between 8.0-8.4 in a recognized Master of Science or fee waiver while the candidates is on shore at Western.

Scholarship Stipend : No WSU scholarship stipend will be awarded.
Candidature Project Funds


WSU will provide candidature project funds (up to the value of \$6000 AUD per annum pro rata for high-cost projects and a lesser amount for low-cost project) for the duration the candidate is onshore at WSU as per agreement.


