Roles & Responsibilities

Terms of Engagement

- Appointment shall be made initially for one year and extendable to 3 years in accordance with the **UGC Guidelines for Professor of Practice** and the relevant rules/regulations of CCS Haryana Agricultural University.
- Honorarium/Remuneration and category of engagement is negotiable as per UGC/University guidelines.
- Other terms and conditions will be as per UGC/University guidelines prescribed for Professor of Practice.
- Professor of Practice shall not be entitled to any LTC or medical reimbursement or any benefits related to pension.
- The Professor of Practice may be relieved by providing one month's notice or through mutual consent with or without assigning any reason.
- The University shall not be liable to pay any grant to Professor of Practice for visiting abroad.
- In case of any ambiguity or unforeseen condition, the orders of the Vice-Chancellor will be final.
- However, the Vice Chancellor will have the power to add or relax any term and conditions as deemed appropriate in the interest of the students and the University.
