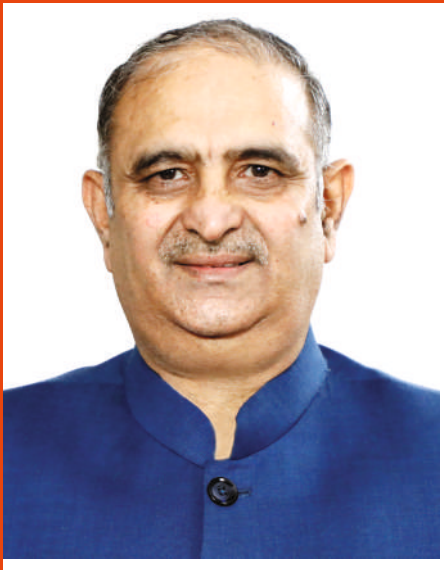

Message

From The President

Agriculture along with the allied sectors is the principal source of livelihoods in India with almost two-third population of rural households still dependent primarily upon agriculture for their livelihood. The largest industries of the country like sugar, jute, textiles, food processing, milk, etc. are dependent on agriculture for their raw materials.

CCS Haryana Agriculture University is imparting education in agriculture and allied areas. It has been realized with time, that most of the unemployed but educated youth have innovative ideas but generally don't have expertise and infrastructure facilities for starting business unit in agriculture and allied disciplines. Many of them aspire to acquire new skill sets and gain hands on experience on use of technology but they lack in know-how about technologies, quality assurance and certification procedures and their implementation. These youth need hand holding and support to emerge as confident and skilled entrepreneurs in agriculture and allied sectors.

In order to strengthen the entrepreneurial activities in the agricultural related fields in the state, CCSHAU has established an Agribusiness Incubation Centre (ABIC) with focus on innovations, skill building and entrepreneurship development in agriculture and allied sectors.

ABIC has been set up in CCSHAU, to provide guidance, technology and infrastructure and focus on capacity building through counseling, training, technical and business advisory services related to agriculture and allied areas for helping the students, farmers, unemployed youth, entrepreneurs for starting, running and sustaining the business in different areas of agriculture with the emphasis on quality assurance and safety parameters, certification, branding and marketing of different products.

This Centre not only helps the agripreneurs to develop skills for establishing their own units, generate employment for others and build wealth to develop themselves into Small and Medium Entrepreneurs but also works to provide end-to-end solutions for innovators and entrepreneurs in commercially testing their agri-business models and also to upscale their business ideas.

Continuous handholding support in terms of capacity building, product development, knowledge dissemination, business expansion etc. by the Centre is expected to benefit many budding entrepreneurs in the State over a period of time and generate gainful employment.

I believe that ABIC will work as catalyst for developing an ecosystem conducive for growth of agripreneurship in the State and provide impetus to "Start-up" culture.

Agribusiness Incubation Centre (ABIC) CCSHAU-Hisar, supports startups in agri and allied sector in different forms. ABIC was established with financial support from NABARD. In order to further nurture incubation ecosystem, the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmer Welfare, Govt. of India supported PM-RKVY scheme on Agribusiness Incubators (R-ABI) is also in operation at ABIC, CCSHAU, Hisar.

This incubation Centre is intended to nurture all intended potential agripreneurs with the assistance provided by RKVY-RAFTAAR scheme on Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied sector Rejuvenation. Under this scheme there is a provision of incubation program which aimed at providing an opportunity to entrepreneurs with focus on students/ youth & farmers to work on their innovative ideas in Agribusiness by imparting one month training cum hands on internship with other startups in Agriculture and allied sectors. Guided by experienced and innovative startups, they will be able to understand business concepts/nuances, strategy and practical insights of specific industries or markets, challenges and strategies to resolve them. After successful completion of last year incubation programme ABIC will provide another opportunity of one month incubation programme for the students, entrepreneurs, innovators, farmers and startups pitching for grant-in-Aid up to 25 lakh during 2026-27 to benefit the buddy entrepreneurs with focus on Agriculture and allied sectors.

Anyone having an innovative idea/minimum viable product based on technology, service, business platform etc. for increasing efficiency in agriculture and allied sectors become eligible to join the programmes.

Impact Created

Across seven completed cohorts, 280 incubates have undergone training and 77 startups have been sanctioned grant-in-aid of approximately Rs.10 crore from Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, New Delhi.

R-ABI CCSHAU Hisar offers following programme for potential agripreneurs/start-ups

Incubation Programme : This is a one month programme meant for potential startup agribusiness having innovative idea based technology, services, business platforms or minimum viable product (MVP) and wish to translate it to marketable stage & scale up the product/business.

Some of the key objectives of R-ABI are related to

- a. Promotion of the culture of Agri startups.
- b. Promotion of innovation, entrepreneurship and business creation in agriculture and allied sectors.
- c. Facilitate evolution of an agri-startup ecosystem by support for cost effective, value added services including technical, legal, financial, intellectual property and regulatory compliance related services to agripreneurs.
- d. Generation of innovative solution to meet local & global agriculture and business challenges and competitiveness.

OBJECTIVE

- To nurture potential agripreneurs by providing training cum internship with other startups to provide them practical, technical and business insights.
- To develop an innovative idea based on technology, service, business platforms etc. into prototype/ product, services/ platforms etc. and launching of a business based on that
- To enable translation of minimum viable product (MVP) to marketable stage and scale up the product and business.
- To provide a platform for faster experimentation and modification in their Approaches or minimum viable product (MVP) based on innovative solutions /Processes /products/services / business models etc. for scaling up.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Applicant should have a minimum viable product (MVP) based on innovative solutions/products/ services/ business models in agriculture & allied sector.
- The recipient should be a registered legal entity in India with a minimum of one month of residency at the R-ABI.
- The recipient has to be an Indian start-up as per DIPP notification. This support is not meant for Indian Subsidiaries of MNCs/foreign companies.
- A startup supported once will not be eligible for applying for the subsequent round of seed support to any R-ABIs.

***The grant in aid amount is subject to completion of training, screening process and recommendations made by the committee and final approval by the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmer's Welfare, GoI.**
