Foundation Stone of ABIC

NABARD Chairman Harsh Kumar Bhanwala laid the foundation stone for Agri Business Incubation Centre (ABIC) in CCS Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar on February 2, 2018. The ABIC at HAU is among the first two centres funded by NABARD anywhere in the country, the other being in Madurai district of Tamil Nadu. NABARD has sanctioned a grant assistance of Rs 11.75 crore towards the capital and recurring expenditure of this centres.

Further ABIC has been stregthened by RKVY Scheme of Govt. of india, Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare with an amount of Rs. 2.33 crore.




