

CAMPUS SCHOOL HOUSE SYSTEM

In Campus School a 'House' is a homely unit away from home. It implies that in the school, the inmates are provided a homely atmosphere to feel comfortable. While the classrooms give a child, necessary academic climate, in the House he learns and develops those essential qualities which equip him sufficiently enough to face life confidently. He learns and develops his all round personality by attaining the highest physical, mental, psychological and social development of which he is capable. It is to practice good manners, self reliance, cooperation, team spirit, regard for others, adaptability, sense of duty and responsibility, sense of belongingness and traits of citizenship. So, 'A HOUSE SYSTEM IS AN INSTITUTION BY ITSELF WITHIN AN INSTITUTION.'

OBJECTIVES OF HOUSE SYSTEM :

- To acquaint students to school life.
- To groom physical, mental, psychological, social and emotional abilities.
- To help socialization of students and to integrate themselves well into corporate life.
- To foster the sense of responsibility to perform the tasks in life earnestly and discharge them well.
- To prepare pupils to play different kinds of roles in a group or community.
- To develop child's personality and integrity;
- To develop the spirit of healthy competition among the children.
- To inculcate the qualities of self-confidence and respect for others' views and opinions; and to take their own decisions on issues and problems at hand.
- To develop fraternity and harmony among the pupils.
- To inculcate in the child a feeling of respect for seniors, elders, teachers and a caring attitude towards juniors.
- To learn to live, endure, enjoy together and develop sensitivity for the feelings and needs of others.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE HOUSE ON DUTY:

- To conduct the Morning Assembly.
- To ensure proper arrival and departure of students from open air theatre.
- To collect, prepare and present news of international, national, state level, etc. in the assembly.
- To preach a thought for the day in the assembly.
- To prepare speech/ poem/skit/drama/song/quiz or any other students' orientated presentation for the assembly.
- To write 'Thought For The Day ' and general knowledge questions on the school entrance board.
- To help in maintaining order and discipline during school hours.
- To participate enthusiastically in all Intra-House and Inter-House contests.

NAME, COLOUR AND ALLOTMENT OF HOUSES:

Each child must be allotted a house on the day he/she is admitted to the school.

The students are divided into five Houses which are named after great Indian philosophers: Gandhi, Nehru, Subhash, Tagore and Vivekananda.

Colours of House flags, badges, T-Shirts, etc. are green, blue, red, yellow and white, respectively. The house T-shirt is to be worn by the students every Wednesday for House Assembly and when they participate in Inter House Activities (sports/march past parade, etc.)

HOUSE APPOINTMENTS AND THEIR DUTIES:

Each house should select the students as:

HOUSE CAPTAIN -1

HOUSE VICE-CAPTAIN -2

The selection should be done in consultation with all the house teachers.

HOUSE VICE-CAPTAIN:

- To assist the House Captain in smooth functioning of house.

HOUSE CAPTAIN:

- To ensure that the 'House' maintains punctuality in all scholastic and non-scholastic activities as per daily routine.
- To facilitate the House Incharge to conduct morning assembly.
- To ensure that all the students in the 'House' devote sufficient time for specific activities.
- To controls his/her 'House' during the conduct of all Inter-House activities;
- To ensure that maximum number of children take part in various co-curricular, sports/games and other activities planned in the school.
- To assist House Incharge in selecting best talent of the house for participation in Inter-House competitions.
- To maintains good personal conduct and ensure proper discipline in the 'House'.
- To ensures good discipline during celebration.
- To carry out all duties assigned by the Principal.
- To reports to Principal in case he/she observes an unusual behavior of any student (such as persistent depression, rebelliousness continued sickness, etc.)

HOUSE TEACHERS:

In a House System, House Incharge is assisted by the teachers of that House. They should provide assistance to House Incharge and carry out all House responsibilities assigned to them.

HOUSE INCHARGE:

Normally, senior teacher may be appointed as House Incharge. As far as possible Art, Music, Physical Education Teacher/Game Organizer and Librarian may not be given the responsibilities of specific house since they are commonly attached to all 'Houses' for the conduct of Inter House Activities. The school house system revolves around the personality, capability and effectiveness of the House Incharge. He/She is the leader of the House. He/She should be able to motivate and guide all the children placed under his/her care. He/She must ensure that children of his House participate in all the Inter House activities and also do well. He is responsible for overall welfare of all children in his house. House Incharges may be rotated as and when required.

HOUSE- COORDINATOR:

He/she coordinates different houses for smooth running of the system, ensures that the house competition and activities are organized as planned and keeps the record to award the House Trophy. He/she should monitor all the Inter House activities carried out in the school under the guidance of Principal. He/she may ensure that CCA and Sports/games competitions are regularly carried out in the school, based on the calendar of activities planned during the beginning of academic term every year.

PLANNING FOR INTER-HOUSE COMPETITIONS/TOURNAMENTS:

House Incharge is personally responsible for the participation of his house to take part in all Inter-House scholastic and non-scholastic activities in the school. He is supported by all the teachers who are attached with him for proper management of the House. A House team should take pride in grooming various teams for Inter-House activities in order to win various trophies and awards, under overall guidance of the Principal Campus School.

ONLINE REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS FOR PARTICIPATION IN CBSE SPORTS EVENTS:

The Incharge of each House will select the students/players/teams (under the guidance of Game Organizer, if needed), prepare a list and submit to the House Coordinator for registration and participation in CBSE sports events.

The same process will be followed during inter House sports events and Athletic Meet.

TROPHIES:

- 1. SPORTS TROPHY:** It will be awarded on the annual occasion of Athletic Meet. The House scoring maximum points in the games/sports activities held during the session and in the events held during Athletic Meet will be declared as a Champion House and will be awarded Sports Trophy.
- 2. OVERALL TROPHY:** It will also be awarded annually on the occasion of Annual Prize Distribution Function. House scoring maximum points in sports as well as in other Inter-House Competitions, mentioned in School Calendar of a session will be declared as the Winner/Champion House and will be felicitated with Overall Trophy.
In case of any discrepancy the final decision will be taken by the jury headed by the Principal, Campus School.

AWARD OF POINTS FOR ACTIVITIES:

For Inter House activities, following pattern of awarding of points may be followed-

Position	Points
First	5
Second	3
Third	2


A system of awarding of points based on performance may be evolved and points earned by each student/team should be credited to the House to which he/she/it belongs.


CHAMPION HOUSE:

Every year by the end of October, points awarded for Inter House CCA and sports/games competitions to each House should be totaled up to declare a Champion House. Champion House Trophy may be awarded to the winner House in Founder's Day And Annual Prize Distribution Function.
