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2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.		On line teaching requires different approach and strategies than off line teaching and also poses challenges for teachers as well as students. It is not only important to complete the courses in time but the learning of students is equally important. To complete the syllabus of courses in time , multiple platforms were used to reach the students. The classes were held on line platforms like Google Meet. Recording of class room lecture was shared with the students who were unable to log in the class due to one or the other reason so that they could access it as per their convenience. To ensure the availability and accessibility of teaching material to all students the material was posted on HRMS portal of the University, through e mail. Whatsapp groups of students were formed and the course material was also posted on these groups. Main points of lecture were also shared through ppts. For completion of practical work, assignments were given to the students and they were motivated for timely submission of assignments. Timely checking and grading of assignments was done and feedback was provided to the students regarding where they were lacking and suggestions for improvement. Video call with the individual students was done during practical classes to check whether they were doing the practical work or not. It was really challenging to reach the students residing in distantly located villages and slum areas having problems of poor net work and erratic poor supply. These students were contacted individually and their suggestions and feedback were obtained to improve online teaching. To keep such students engaged and motivated quizzes, extra help sessions through live chatting and video conferencing were organized. On line teaching requires flexibility; hence some time classes were adjusted according to the convenience of the students. If there was network problem or power failure during the class, extra classes were taken even during off time of the college and on holidays.
