- i. The minimum requirement of completion of satisfactory course and research work is of 5 Semesters. Prior to submission of the thesis, the students complete research work as per approved draft of thesis synopsis under the supervision of Major Advisor.
- ii. After submission of thesis by the Ph.D. student, the same is evaluated by at least two expert external examiners. On receipt of satisfactory evaluation reports, the Ph.D. students undergo a viva-voce examination with one expert external examiner who evaluates the thesis, which is also openly defended in the presence of academicians.

Therefore, the Ph.D. degree awarded by CCSHAU, Hisar is in accordance with the provision of the University Grant Commission, Regulation 2009, New Delhi.
