ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1973

Whereas, it has been made to appear to me that there is a likely hood of disturbance of public peace and tranquility on account of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19).

And whereas, I, am satisfied that immediate measures are needed to be taken for prevention of such danger to human health and safety of general public, hence there is apprehension of spread of nCOVID-19 in case

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of section 144 of Code of Criminal procedure, 1973. I, Dr. Priyanka Soni, IAS, District Magistrate, Hisar do hereby prohibit the gathering of five or more than five persons in public places in the jurisdiction of District Hisar.

Even in case the assembly is less than twenty persons, it will be ensured that social distancing norms circulated by the Government of India in the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) will be followed, However, movement of people in public transport or in any other mode of transport especially in the eventuality of medical emergencies will be exempted from this order.

This order shall not apply to the Police/Military/Para Military Forces and other public servants on duty.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force till 03.05.2020 if not revoked earlier.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code. Superintendent of Police, Hisar and Hansi shall be responsible for implementation of this order.

In view of requirement of the situation which has become emergent, this order is being passed ex-parte as being addressed to the public in general.

This order shall be promulgated by announcement through publicity van of the Public Relations Department and by affixing copies of the order on Notice Board in the District Court, Sub Divisional Courts, Tehsil Courts, Police Stations, Municipal Council/Municipal Committees, Panchayats, Block and Zila Parisad offices in the District of Hisar by the District Information and Public Relations Officer, Hisar.

The Superintendent of Police, Hisar/Hansi and Sub Divisional Magistrates in their respective areas shall be responsible for enforcement of the above prohibitory orders in letter and spirit.
