



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

Maharana Partap Horticultural University (MHU), Karnal
and
Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University,
Hisar

PREAMBLE

This MoU is made between Maharana Partap Horticultural University (hereinafter called MHU) with its headquarter at Karnal and presently camp office at CCS HAU, Hisar as one party and the Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University with its headquarter at Hisar as the other party. Whereas the parties which wish to establish a friendly relationship to promote and extend the facilities in the areas teaching, research and extension of mutual concern, have decided to enter into this MoU and agree, hereby as per articles given below:

ARTICLE-I

The parties, hereby, agree for promotion of academic activities with their responsibilities as under:

- i) Maharana Partap Horticultural University (MHU) came into being on 28.11.2016 by enactment of Haryana Act No. 32 of 2016. The University has set up its camp office at CCS HAU Campus on 21.01.2017. MHU has decided to start PG Programmes in the disciplines of Fruit Science, Floriculture & Landscape Architecture and Vegetable Science from the current academic session 2017-18. Being newly established university, infrastructural facilities are to be created. As an alternative, MHU wish to use academic facilities such as faculty manpower, laboratories, library, hostels, class-rooms, research farm etc available with CCS HAU for imparting quality education to the students to be enrolled in MHU.
- ii) The above disciplines of PG Programmes to which admissions are to be made by MHU shall be open for academic collaboration with CCS HAU under the MoU provided the proposed research aspect is covered in the mandate of MHU.
- iii) The admissions in MHU will be made on the basis of merit list of entrance exam conducted by CCS HAU for PG Programmes.
- ✓ iv) The teaching load will be shared by the faculty of MHU after its recruitment. The faculty of MHU may also be associated as Committee Members.
- ✓ v) Major Advisors and Committee Members shall be from CCS HAU till regular appointment of faculty in MHU.
- vi) Facilities of boarding and lodging shall be provided to the PG students of MHU on the pattern and same rate as prescribed by CCS HAU for its students.
- ✓ vii) CCS HAU will allow its library and other facilities like laboratories, class-rooms, research area, hospital etc. to the students of MHU without charging any cost. The use of these

- facilities between the students of CCS HAU and MHU will be mutually decided so that academic activities may run smoothly.
- viii) The fee will be collected by MHU and if needed may be shared with mutual consent of both the Universities.
 - ix) The programme of work, synopsis etc. shall be approved by Dean PGS of MHU. The grades of PG students will be submitted to Dean PGS, MHU by Dean PGS, CCS HAU.
 - x) The examination of PG students of MHU will be got conducted alongwith students of CCS HAU as per rules and regulation of CCS HAU.
 - xi) The students shall submit thesis to the MHU. The students shall be required to submit no dues certificate of both Universities as per pattern of CCS HAU. The degrees in regard to PG Programmes will be conferred to successful students by MHU as envisaged under Section-7 (a) of Maharana Pratap Horticultural University Act, 2015 (Haryana Act No. 32 of 2016).

ARTICLE-II

- i) The research work while pursuing Post Graduation by the students in different disciplines shall be open for collaboration under the MoU provided research aspect is covered in the mandate of both the parties.
- ii) The student would invariably be the senior author for the publications arising out of the research work conducted at the CCS HAU/MHU followed by Major Guide/Advisor and Co-major Advisor/Co-Guide in that order. The names of additional co-authors, depending upon their contribution in the research work, may be decided by mutual consent between the student and Major Guide/Advisor.

ARTICLE-III


The student will be expected to protect the Intellectual Property Rights generated or likely to be generated during his/her research work. CCS HAU and MHU shall be the joint applicants for IPRs and the student and involved scientific/teaching staff shall be included as inventor/breeder/author. Intellectual property and benefits arising out of commercialization of technologies generated out of co-operation under this agreement shall be jointly shared by CCS HAU and MHU on mutual decision in each case.

ARTICLE-IV

The parties to this MoU may, by mutual consent, add, modify, amend or delete any word, phrase, sentence, or article in this MoU at any time during the operation of MoU with mutual consent and approval of Vice-Chancellor's of both Universities.

ARTICLE-V

The MoU shall be effective from the date of its signing by both the parties and shall remain in operation for initially for a period of five years however it can be reduced or extended with approval of Vice-Chancellor's of both Universities.



ARTICLE-VI

A joint follow up committee consisting of Dean PGS, DR, Dean, COH/Dean, COA of both Universities will meet periodically for the execution of this MoU and suggest necessary measures, if any for further improvement of collaboration in terms of teaching, research, extension, financial and other modalities as per need and rules and regulations of both the Universities.

ARTICLE-VII


The activities relating to research and extension will also be carried out jointly with mutual consent of competent authorities of both Universities.

ARTICLE-VIII






