
- Purchase be effected of other than shortlisted brands in emergent cases only on the satisfaction of HOD or as per prescribed purchase procedure through GeM.



3. It was further decided that if, any other request is received from Manufacturer/dealer for entering into rate contract/Brand Selection, the Brand selection Committee was of the view that the Chairman of the Brand Selection Committee is authorized to approve the proposed brand depending upon the merits of the chemical/equipment/plasticware/houseware etc.

4. As per the decision of the CPC the approved Rate Contracts of various Indian Agents/Distributors of same foreign Manufacturer having same brands (foreign) and products should be compared first in quality and rates by the Indentors before placing the Supply Order and in case the guidelines are not followed the Indentor shall be responsible.

The Departments may take further necessary action strictly as per approved brands of Rate Contract during the period.


**Subject: Guidelines/policy for the purchase of new furniture.**




